Vusi Mchunu is a South African poet, heritage practitioner, film researcher, writer and producer. A political exile to Berlin, Germany (1982-1993), he is the 2022 South African Literary Awards, lifetime achievement award winner for his multiple poetry books including Stronger Souls - Poems, Essays and Graphics by Lefifi Tladi, Pipedreams – 450 Zulu poems of Mazisi Kunene translated by Vusi Mchunu, Pleiades-iSiliMela – 100 poems by Vusi Mchunu, Kraal to Eternity – iSibaya saPhakade; 100 Zulu poems of Sandile Ngidi translated by Vusi Mchunu.

He has a Master of Arts from the Free University of Berlin, 1992, and has founded the heritage solutions outfit, House of Memory (2007 – 2014) and co-founder of the Sausage Film Company in 2020.

Vusi has curated multiple museums of cultural heritage: Haus der Kulturen der Welt(Berlin, Germany) AmaNdebele-People of Colour, Transnet Railway Museums, Samora Machel in Mbuzini, Nomoya Masilela in Bethal, African National Congress 100 years' anti- Apartheid icons sculptures in KZN, Joburg's Downtown Music Hub Museum, DOC Matiwane Family Museum in Pietermaritzburg, Kruger National Park Museum, Swazi King Sobhuza Museum in Piggs Peak, Alexandra Heritage Centre, South African Air Force Museum at Zwartkop Military Air Base. He was Chairperson of Freedom Park Council (2013 – 2016). Chief Director Heritage for the Department of Military Veterans (2017 – 2019). He is currently Associate at heritage solutions company, Creative Repair & A/42 and publisher of "Unauthorised Online Newsletter." A cancer survivor with a speech impediment, Vusi has a twenty year working relationship with Busi Mhlongo.
